"Waterfalls and Historical Mystery" Be prepared to be amazed! We will

travel a short distance from the hotel east up the Columbia Gorge via motor coach to the wonderful natural phenomenon, **Multnomah Falls**, long time #1 tourist attraction in the state! The land surrounding the falls was developed by Simon Benson (Benson Hotelier)



in the early-twentieth century, with a pathway, viewing bridge, and adjacent lodge being constructed in 1925. The **Multnomah Falls** Lodge and the surrounding footpaths at the falls were added to the National Register of Historic Places in 1981.

As Oregon's most celebrated waterfall, **Multnomah Falls** attracts nearly two million visitors from around the world every year. **Formed** by the cataclysmic Missoula Floods beginning 15,000 years ago and fed mainly by underground springs, **Multnomah Falls** drops 635 feet in two major tiers down basalt cliffs. Bring your cameras!



After all the photo - ops, we will re-board our magic coach for a 20-minute ride to the historic **McMenamins Edgefield Lodge** for dinner and so much more! The property, opened in 1911 as a county poor farm was long abandoned and eventually purchased in 1990 by the visionary McMenamin brothers who transformed it into a destination: a hotel, winery, brewery, pub, distillery, spa, and much more. Seventy-Five acres of gardens, par 3 golf course, outdoor music venue and all in keeping with the original ambiance of the 20's and 30's with the brother's unusual, creative, and quirky touch. The artwork is amazing! Over the course of twenty-plus years, the art evolved into an expression of the building's history, the company's mission and of McMenamins itself. *Some say it might be haunted.* For the brave souls of us, you are invited on an optional scavenger hunt to explore all the mysteries hidden within this unique historical destination. Casual dress, walking shoes, a light sweater, your adventurous spirit and the ever-handly camera is all you need for an experience you won't soon forget!"
